ABOUT THIS EVENING'S ARTISTS

Soobeen Nam was born in South Korea. She started playing violin at the age of five, influenced by her musical family including her mother who plays flute and her sister who plays cello. Even at an early age, Soobeen earned top prizes in violin competitions and, thus, in middle school, decided to pursue a career as a professional violinist.

She studied with Jiří Novotný, a professor at the Konzervatoř Brno (Brno Conservatory), and with Vítězslav Zavadilík, a member of Janáček String Quartet. Soobeen also played with the Czech Virtuosi at the age of thirteen. She was certified at the Music education institution in Dong-Eul University and at the Music education institution in Pusan University at age of fifteen.

She graduated from Busan Art High School, where she studied with Young hee Kim, Jae-jin Baek, and Jieun Kim. After graduating from high school, Soobeen came to Park University International Center for Music to study with violin master Ben Sayevich, and she is pursuing a Bachelor's Degree in Violin performance.



Sihao Qin began playing piano at the age of 5. He was admitted to the Central Conservatory of Music Middle School in Beijing, China; and studied with Zhiwei Zhang and Qifang Li. Since 2017, he has attended The Barstow School and Young Artists Music Academy in Kansas City. He currently studies with Stanislav loudenitch in Park University.

He has received awards in several piano competitions including The Fourth Shenzhen Piano Open Competition and Young Musicians International Competition in Los Angeles. He Performed with National Symphony Orchestra of Uzbekistan and Jilin Symphony Orchestra.
